REQUEST FOR BIDS

In general, the Work consists of the installation of six new turnouts to agricultural lands that have recently been annexed into the Orland-Artois Water District. The project will involve the tapping of existing OAWD pipelines, extension of pipelines, pipeline crossings of Glenn County roadways, and installation of new turnouts and meters.

1. Sealed bids will be received by the Orland-Artois Water District prior to **2:00:00 p.m.** (local time) on **November 12, 2025** at 6505 County Road 27, Orland, CA. 95963, and following said deadline all bids will be publicly opened and read. Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope with the name of the bidder, the name of the project and the statement **“Do Not Open Until the Time of Bid Opening.”** Bids received after said deadline will be returned unopened to the bidder.
2. A mandatory **pre-bid meeting and project site tour** will be held on **October 31, 2025 beginning at 10:00 a.m.** Meeting will begin at the District Office at 6505 County Road 27, Orland, CA. 95963. Contractors shall personally examine the project site prior to bidding.
3. Bid documents may be obtained from Provost & Pritchard Consulting Group (Engineer) at no cost. **Interested parties must contact Provost & Pritchard Consulting Group at (866) 776-6200 or email Mallory Serrao (mserrao@ppeng.com)** to register as a plan holder and receive the bid documents.
4. Questions must be received by **5:00 p.m. on November 6, 2025.** Questions may be submitted by email to Mallory Serrao (mserrao@ppeng.com). Answers to questions will be provided to all bidders who provide an email address on the mandatory pre-bid meeting sign in sheet.
5. Prevailing Wage Rates: Pursuant to Section 1770, California Labor Code, the successful Bidder shall pay not less than the prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of California Department of Industrial Relations. Prevailing wage rate information is available on the internet at the following website address: <http://www.dir.ca.gov/dlsr/PWD>.
6. This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations. No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project (awarded on or after April 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5.
7. Bidders shall furnish a Bid Security with their Bidder's Proposal in the amount of 10% of the base bid amount.
8. The Engineer's opinion of probable construction cost is: \$558,113.
9. Owner reserves the right after opening Bids to reject any or all Bids, to waive any informality or non-responsiveness in a Bid, or to make award to the lowest responsive, responsible Bidder and reject all other Bids, as it may best serve the interest of the Owner.
10. Contractor's License Classification: In accordance with the provisions of California Public Contract Code, Section 3300, Orland-Artois Water District has determined that bidder shall possess a valid **Class A Contractor's License** issued by the State of California at the time of Bid opening and for the duration of the contract. Failure to possess the specified licenses
